DAY 01: JRO– LAKE TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK

Upon arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport, you will be met and assisted by our representative for safari briefing later be transferred to Lake Tarangire National Park. The lodge is 196 KM away from the airport, this drive takes about 3hours 20minutes .Arrive in time for lunch and check in.

Later go for an afternoon game drive. Tanzania's third largest National Park often referred to as **"The Elephant Paradise"** because it is home to one of the largest concentrations of elephants in Africa. The park is one of the best bird watching locations in Tanzania. The park boasts over 500 bird species, including pale-billed hornbills, tawny eagles, and Bateleur eagles, as well as migratory birds like European bee-eaters and lilac-breasted rollers. The park is famous for its **giant baobab trees**, which are scattered throughout the landscape. These ancient trees, sometimes known as “upside-down trees” because of their unusual shape, create an otherworldly atmosphere and are one of the park's most iconic features. DAY 02: FULL DAY IN LAKE TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK

On this day you will spend the entire day exploring the park as it offers a rich and immersive wildlife experience, characterized by its striking landscapes and diverse animal sightings. After having your breakfast you will head out for a morning game drive as the sun rises over the savannah, bathing the park in golden light. The early hours are ideal for spotting predators like lions and leopards while they are still active, as well as large herds of elephants one of Tarangire's most iconic features gathering near the Tarangire River to drink and socialize.

As you traverse the park, you'll pass through acacia woodlands, open grasslands, and dense baobab groves, each hosting a unique array of wildlife such as giraffes, zebras, wildebeests, impalas, and over 500 species of birds. Return to the lodge and have your lunch as you prepare to head for an afternoon game drive.

Later head out for the afternoon game drive, it provides further opportunities to observe the park's rich ecosystem, possibly including rare sightings of Lesser Kudu, the tree-climbing pythons for which Tarangire is known. As the sun sets, casting long shadows and a warm glow across the landscape, return to the lodge for dinner and overnight.

DAY 03: TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK – SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

After breakfast, guests check out and depart for Serengeti National Park, the drive is about 237 KM and this takes approximately 4 hours and 45minutes. Drive straight to the camp with a scenic game drive enroute.

The camp is strategically located in the southern part of the Serengeti ecosystem, near the border with the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. Arrive at the camp in time for lunch and relaxation. The camp is in the heart of the park designed to minimize environmental impact, with mobile infrastructure that leaves no trace upon relocation. Enjoy an evening game drive across the savannah full of flora and fauna in its natural habitat. Return back to the camp for dinner and overnight.

DAY 04: FULL DAY SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

Wake up early for breakfast then depart with packed lunch for a full day game viewing drive as you explore the park across the vast short-grass plains of the southern Serengeti and Ndutu area an iconic part of the Greater Serengeti ecosystem and a hotspot for the Great Migration during the calving season (typically December to March). The annual wildebeest migration is Serengeti's most famous attraction. It is also home to a pride of lions which have been fitted with radio-transmitter collars so that their movements may be tracked. Other wildlife you may see includes elephant herds, giraffes, jackals, and leopards, the views in the park are truly unmatched and impossible to forget. Later return back to the camp for dinner and overnight.

DAY 05: NDUTU – CENTRAL SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

After breakfast check out of the camp with en-route game viewing. Embark on a journey to central region of Serengeti National Park in Seronera, known for its rich year round wildlife due to permanent water sources and diverse ecosystems. The distance takes 81km approximately 1hour 55minutes away.

Arrive at the camp in time for lunch and check in. The camp is comfortable, eco-friendly ideally situated for exploring the central plains. After having your lunch and some rest, you will head out for an evening game drive. During the evening game drive you may witness large predators such as lions and leopards often become active in the evening preparing for a night of hunting. Elephants may be seen heading to or from the river, and hippos begin to stir from their daytime wallows. You may also encounter hyenas, jackals, warthogs, impalas, topis, waterbucks, reedbucks and



smaller nocturnal creatures beginning to emerge. As the sun dips low on the horizon return to the camp and overnight.

DAY 06: FULL DAY SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

Wake up early for breakfast then depart with packed lunch for a full day game viewing drive as you explore the central plains of the park. The will begin with a morning game drive during morning hours it is the prime time to spot predators like lions, leopards, and cheetahs as they finish hunting or start to move for the day. You may also see elephants, buffalos, and giraffes feeding in the morning light. Along riverbanks, hippos returning to water after grazing all night, and crocodiles bask in the warmth of the new day.

In the afternoon you will have your lunch at a picnic site where you can enjoy a packed picnic lunch under shade, often with views of nearby wildlife. During the heat of the day, many animals rest in the shade, but you may still encounter herds of zebras, wildebeests, and antelopes grazing on the plains or near water sources. After a short rest, you will continue with an afternoon game drive. The afternoon game drive takes you through varied habitats: open grasslands, riverine forests, and rocky kopjes. You might witness elephants bathing in muddy pools, or spot leopards lounging in acacia trees. Birdwatchers will also enjoy sightings of colorful species like the lilac-breasted roller, secretary birds, and raptors circling above. Later return to the camp for dinner and overnight.

DAY 07: SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK – NGORONGORO CONSERVATION AREA

After breakfast and check out of the lodge with en-route game view. Embark on a journey to Ngorongoro Conservation Area the 8th Wonder of the world largest intact crater. The drive covers 187km approximately 3hours 55minutes. Along the drive, you will enjoy views of rolling hills, forests and coffee plantations.

Upon arrival at the lodge you will be welcomed by the beautiful sceneries of the crater and beautiful landscape. Arrive at the lodge in time for lunch and check in. Later in the afternoon head out for afternoon game drive on the crater floor which is a home to several wildlife including lions, cheetahs, leopards, cape buffaloes among others. You will enjoy spotting of various bird species such as pink flamingo along the shores of Lake Magadi. Later ascend for dinner and overnight.

DAY 08: FULL DAY VISIT TO LAKE EYASI

Guests will depart in the morning with picnic lunches packed for the journey to Lake Eyasi. The scenic drive offers glimpses of rural Tanzanian life and breathtaking views of the Rift Valley escarpment. Upon arrival, guests will meet the Hadzabe community, one of Africa's last remaining hunter-gatherer tribes.



They'll have the rare opportunity to learn about traditional hunting techniques, gather edible plants, and witness age-old survival skills. Guests can also participate in cultural exchanges, including traditional dances and storytelling sessions around the campfire. After an enriching day, they'll enjoy their picnic lunch by the lakeshore before heading back to the lodge.

DAY 09: KARATU -ARUSHA

After breakfast check out of the lodge with en-route game view and embark on journey to Arusha. You will drive through the lush highlands of Karatu. As you descend from the highlands, the scenery transitions into the flat, open expanse of the Great Rift Valley, with sweeping views of Lake Manyara and surrounding escarpments. The drive takes 143km approximately 2hours 40minutes.

Arrive at the hotel in late afternoon and check in. The hotel is nestled in the lush foothills of Mount Meru, Tanzania's second-highest peak. Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure you can spent relaxing in the lodge's gardens, taking a nature walk through the surrounding forest or simply relaxing at the comfort of your room.
